## **CONSEQUNCES FOR CODE OF CONDUCT VIOLATION**

**1st Offense:** Athletic Director/Coach will issue a verbal/written warning which is reported to the Administration and School Board at the school.

**2nd Offense:** The Athletic Director will report offense to the Administration/School Board and a parental suspension of one week from practice and games will be issued.

During a Parental Suspension, the student will need to be supervised during the game.

The parent may pick up or drop off, but cannot stay for the practice or game.

**3rd Offense:** A third offense will constitute a permanent ban from games and practices until the end of the season.

If the Parent does not abide by the consequence, the child may be asked to leave the team.
